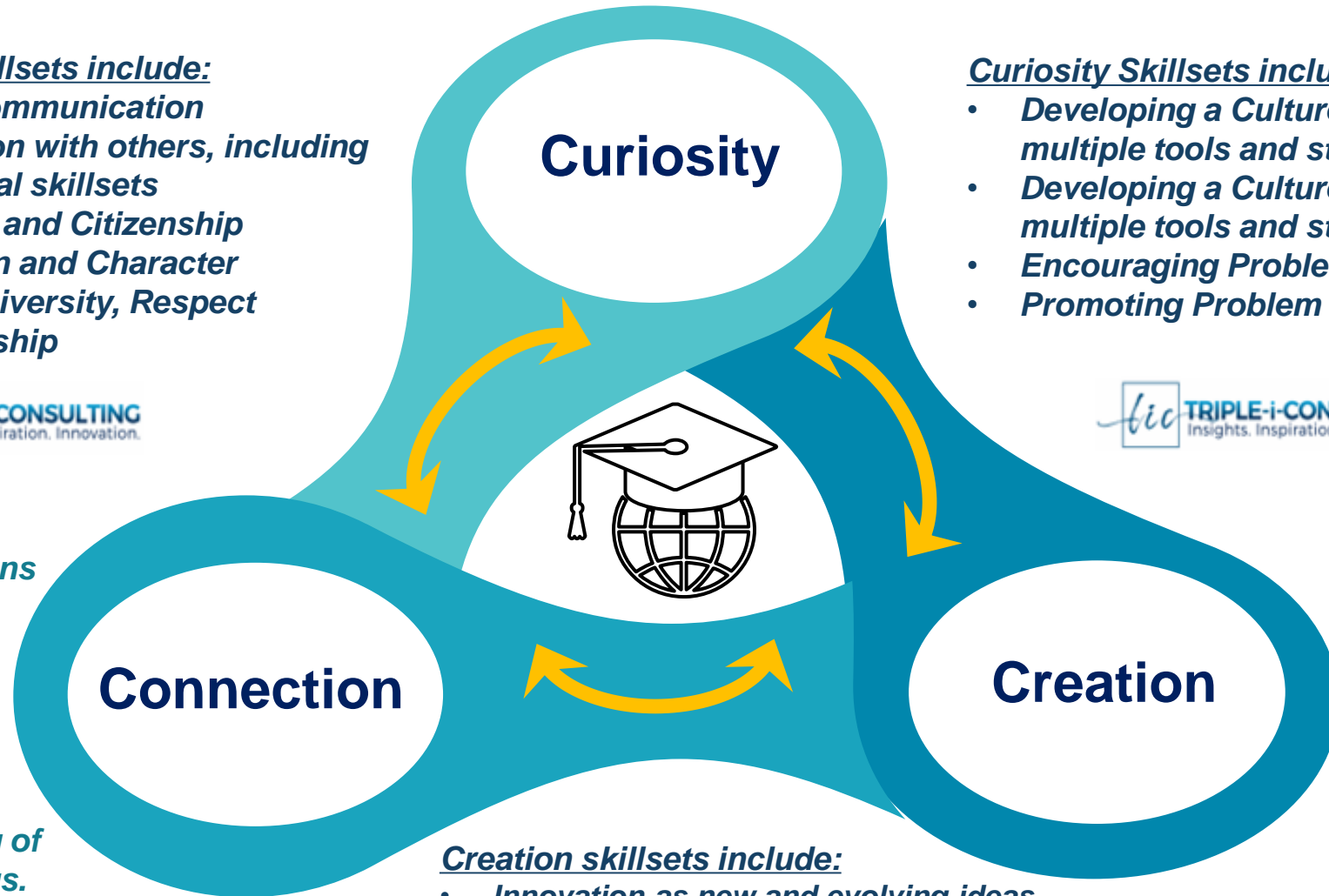
Connection skillsets include:
